Simply Yards completed the landscape refresh projects with the islands on Sundown Court and Washington Court. The two islands look like new with the addition of mulch and may have also noticed that the dead madrona tree by the gazebo was also removed, which opens up the view nicely!

The Washington Boulevard Medians Project will begin in earnest in mid-October. I will provide the community with detailed information on the timeline and exact project dates in the near future. Check the website often for the updates and details.

The Landscape Committee will meet on October 8th to review the bids for the 2019 Annual Landscape Maintenance Contract. The Committee will make a recommendation for the Board to approve at the October 23rd HOA Meeting.

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Neighborhood Notes:

- Traffic safety and speeds are always a hot topic, and as the weather begins to cool and children go back to school, please be more careful and observe the 25-mile per hour speed limit when driving up and/or down the boulevard. Also actively watch for "hazards" of all kinds.
- On Saturday, September 29, from 9am until 2pm, the Transition Fidalgo & Friends group is sponsoring a Fix-It Day at the Anacortes Farmer's Market. Bring those items that need mending or fixing: reuse before you recycle! transitionfidalgo.org
- Remember that the holiday solid waste pick-up will be the Monday after Thanksgiving, not the usual Friday. Also don't forget to put your garbage in bags and tie them

before putting in the cans and out at the curb.

- Please don't feed the deer! Leftover food scraps will attract rats and other vermin, and looks messy. Park and wildlife experts caution against feeding such animals, as it can lead to many problems.
